As your councilmember, I have learned how important it is to “do what you say, and say what you do”.

In a citywide poll 4 years ago, you said that housing for all income levels was important, along with public safety and safe neighborhoods. Since elected, I have been a strong advocate for housing availability for all income levels, added more police officers, and helped to establish the Anaheim Family Justice Center, the first of its kind in the nation, which changes the way that victims of family crimes receive assistance.

I organized a coalition of community leaders which is mobilizing and organizing groups of people to go into problem graffiti areas to knock on doors and engage people to improve their neighborhoods. I have worked with Mayor Pringle in developing ARTIC, the regional transportation hub which will connect all major forms of transportation to Anaheim.

For the past 25 years, I have been the executive director of a faith based child abuse prevention organization which serves our society’s most needy and vulnerable. My life of service is carried over into my deep commitment to Anaheim as well as my belief that true joy in life comes from serving others.
