March 12, 2010 (E-88) Last day to consolidate with Statewide Direct Primary Election. Resolution containing a measure must be to Registrar of Voters by 5:00 p.m. on March 12, 2010. If you wish to have full text printed in the sample ballot, we need to have the full text by March 12, 2010.

March 12, 2010 (E-88)*

Last day for direct arguments and city attorney impartial analysis. If your Council passes a resolution prior to March 12, 2010, adjust the date accordingly.

March 13, 2010 through March 22, 2010 (E-87 - 78) Public Review period for measure text, impartial analysis and direct arguments. Measure documents will be posted on the Registrar of Voters website.

March 15, 2010 (E-85) Registrar of Voters will email measure letter designations to cities that have measures on the ballot.

March 22, 2010 (E-78) Last day for rebuttal arguments. If your direct arguments are due prior to March 12, 2010, the rebuttals must be filed 10 days after the direct arguments.

March 23, 2010 through April 1, 2010 (E-77 - 68) Public Review period for rebuttal arguments. All changes due to court action(s) must be finalized by April 1, 2010, 5:00 p.m., to be included in the Registrar of Voters sample ballot pamphlet.

April 29, 2010 (E-40) Sample ballot pamphlet mailing begins approximately this date. Mailing completed by May 29, 2010.

April 29, 2010 (E-40) Registrar of Voters will mail a list of polling places within your city. They will also be available on the City Clerk Partnership website. You will be notified when this posting occurs.
